2. What does Brenda do? (Campus Minister, short-term missions volunteer coordinator for Iditarod)
3. What is the nickname for the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race? (“The Last Great Race”)
4. What was the Iditarod Trail originally used for? (Mail and supply delivery)
5. Why do people in Alaska need to hear about Jesus? (There aren't many churches, some struggle with addictions or depression, people haven't heard)
6. What is the weather like in Alaska most of the year? (Frigid, snowy, icy)
7. How long is the Iditarod Trail? (More than 1,000 miles)
8. What do short-term missions volunteers do at the Iditarod? (The jobs no one else wants to do, like feeding dogs, cleaning bathrooms, handing out free coffee, running the basketball tournament)
9. What else does Brenda do to reach native Alaskans for Jesus? (Gives Bibles in buckets, becomes friends with college students, watches college students' ballgames)
