

**“Northern Exposure” Review Questions**  
**For Use in the 2009 Youth North American Mission Study**

1. Where does Brenda Crim serve? (At the University of Alaska Anchorage)
2. As a missionary, what is Brenda’s assignment? (She is a campus minister.)
3. How does she get students to come to Bible studies? (She goes to their sports events, meets them, makes friends with them, and invites them to come.)
4. Do all the students who come to her Bible study believe in Jesus? Why? (No. Many are from unchurched families and don’t know much about the Bible or Jesus. They come because Brenda makes them feel welcome and they begin to want to know more.)
5. Does Brenda work only on the UAA college campus? (No, she does ministry all over Alaska, coordinating volunteer teams for churches, for ministry at the Iditarod Trail Dog Sled Race, and going out into the villages to meet the people and tell them more about Jesus.)
6. What do you think are some things we can pray for Brenda’s ministry and people that live in Alaska? (*You can ask this question more than one time.*) (More churches to start, students to be receptive to hearing about Jesus, students to be active in Bible study so they can become church leaders, people in villages to have physical needs met, people who come to the Iditarod or other tourist places/events in Alaska to hear about Jesus)
7. What do you think are some things a short-term volunteer group could do if they visited Alaska? (Lead VBS in the villages; help distribute Bibles, blankets, food, or personal items to people in need; help build or renovate a church; help with a campus or city outreach event, such as a festival or sporting event)
8. What are some things you think would encourage Brenda, other missionaries, and pastors in Alaska? (Prayer, letters, supplies, gift cards)
